Join our Observer Corps to help monitor city government and its various departments, including: City Council, Department of Planning and Economic Development (PED), and the soccer stadium committee. Additional opportunities to get involved include the Saint Paul School Board and any of the District Councils.

Involved citizens are the backbone of a democratic system but people have to know what is going on in order to make good judgments about the way their government and its departments are operating. Because of Minnesota's strong open meeting laws, citizens are able to attend virtually every meeting of governmental agencies and departments. Join our Observer Corps and help keep elected and appointed officials on their toes and Saint Paul citizens informed.

Requirements:

- Commitment to a definite period of time; ideal candidates will commit to at least 4-6 months.
- Attend the meetings regularly once you commit; usually once a month.
- Write a brief recap of the meeting(s) and send to the designated League of Women Voters board member for reporting.
- Maintain non-partisanship at all meetings, e.g. do not wear campaign buttons, etc.
